

The OGSA Turfgrass Education Awards

SCHOLARSHIP POLICY STATEMENT:

The OGSA has developed this scholarship program to recognize scholastic achievement and leadership in the field of turfgrass management.

FUNDING: <u>Two awards will be presented in denominations of \$1500 each.</u> Applicants can re-apply multiple years providing they still fulfil the criteria but can only be awarded this scholarship once.

SELECTION:

Selection for diploma and degree students will be based on the following:

- Scholastic accomplishment (20%)
- Resume community / industry involvement (20%)
- Leadership & interest in turfgrass management (30%)
- Demonstrated commitment to a career in golf course turfgrass management (20%)
- Application presentation (10%)

TO QUALIFY:

- 1. The applicant must be attending a recognized university or college, be enrolled in a recognized turfgrass program, have successfully completed at least one semester, and have secured employment as a turfgrass employee at an Ontario golf course for the upcoming season.
- 2. The applicant must be an OGSA member in good standing for the year of application.
- 3. Applicants must include:
 - proof of program registration via their most recent transcript.
 - a current resume which includes: contact details, educational background, academic advisor's name and contact details, experience related to turfgrass management, community involvement, and other relevant leadership experience.
 - a letter confirming employment or internship from the Ontario golf course superintendent where they will work throughout the upcoming season.
- 4. The applicant must complete the following questions and provide the following information as part of their essay submission.
 - a) How did you become interested in the Turfgrass profession?
 - b) Why do you feel you would be a good candidate to receive this award?
 - c) What are your goals and objectives upon graduation?
